



Safe Sender Instructions

Due to the large volume of emails generated by CREW Network and its [Contracted Chapter Service](#) clients, some email/internet service providers incorrectly identify our emails as spam. It is necessary to add us to your safe sender list. This tells your email/internet service provider that CREW Network and its chapters are approved senders.

Your email provider or security service (if you use one) has their own instructions for adding email addresses to a safe sender list. Look up instructions with the provider or service you use.

If you use a work email account, you will need to send these instructions to your organization's IT department.
